Day 01

Private road transfer from Cape Town International Airport to More Quarters.

Day 02



You will be collected from More Quarters and taken on a Scheduled full day Peninsula tour including entrance fees for Chapmans Peak, Cape Point and Kirstenbosch. Lunch is excluded.

Transport is by microbus/mini coach seating a maximum of 12 passengers, with the exception of the Christmas and New Year period when larger coaches up to a maximum of 44 passengers may be used.

Scheduled Full Day Peninsula Tour

- Highlights:**
- Coastal Drive
 - Cape of Good Hope
 - Cape Point & Lighthouse
 - Chapman's Peak Drive
 - Penguin Colony at Boulders Beach
 - Seal Colony at Duiker Island

Depart the city along the Atlantic seaboard to the fishing village of Hout Bay, where, as an optional extra, you board a boat to view the Cape fur seal colony on Duiker Island (weather dependent). Alternatively explore the working harbour and visit the fish markets and local shops.

Return to dry land and navigate the 114 curves of 600m high Chapman's Peak Drive, one of the world's most spectacular passes, past the Cape's longest beach at Noordhoek and the coastal hamlets of Kommetjie and Scarborough. Look out for Southern right whales just offshore from June to November!

Enter the Cape of Good Hope section of the Table Mountain National Park with its unique Cape fynbos vegetation and home to birds like African black oystercatchers and Cape sugarbirds as well as to very special fauna including Cape mountain zebra, bontebok (both endemic) and the charismatic Cape baboon.

Climb (or ride the world's first environmentally friendly funicular) to the famous Cape Point Lighthouse to capture the magical vistas of False Bay, and south-westernmost point of Africa: breathtaking Cape Point.

Head along the False Bay coast to Boulders Beach for a close-up encounter with a colony of African penguins, and then head home through the naval village of Simonstown and over Boyes Drive. The last stop of the day is Kirstenbosch Botanical Gardens, for a walk through one of the largest collections of indigenous plants in the world.

Note:

- Transport is by microbus/mini coach, seating a maximum of 11 passengers (excluding high season 16 Dec – 15 Jan where a 44-seater may be used)
- A lunch stop will be made en route although this is not included in the cost.
- The cruise to Seal Island, entrance fee to Boulders Beach and funicular ride at Cape Point are optional extras.

Days 03 and 04

Day 05

Private road transfer from More Quarters to Cape Town International Airport.

Scheduled flight from Cape Town International Airport to Polokwane Airport via Johannesburg (flight costs not included in cost of safari and is an additional cost).

Scheduled transfer from Polokwane Airport to Mashatu Main.

Located in the Northern Tuli Game Reserve, Mashatu Game Reserve is the largest private concession in southern Africa at a massive 25,000 hectares. What's more, it is the embodiment of all that defines Africa – vast open space, an array of wildlife large and small, majestic skies and plenty of adventure. Our 14 tastefully decorated and air-conditioned suites at Mashatu Main Camp each has a double and an extra large single bed, a seating area and en-suite bathroom ensuring a comfortable stay for families and couples alike. The camp has a large swimming pool, a traditional boma, a lounge and dining area and a curio shop. In

addition, The Discovery Room is the portal through which you will catch a glimpse of another world that was here long before man was.

- Mashatu, ‘Land of Giants’ takes its name from the locally-sacrosanct Mashatu tree and the giants that roam its terrain.
