Day 01

Private road transfer from Cape Town Airport to Cape Grace Hotel.

Day 02



You will be collected from the Cape Grace Hotel and taken on a Private Half Day City Tour inclusive of entrance fees to the South African Museum, Castle of Good Hope and the District 6 Museum (closed Sundays). Lunch is excluded.

Private Half Day City Tour

Highlights

- Haggle in the colorful and bustling market of Greenmarket Square.
- Explore the rich history, culture and architecture of Cape Town including Company Gardens, Castle of Good Hope, Grande Parade and the District Six Museum.
- Explore the colorful Cape Malay Quarter.

Drive through the city via the vibrant Bo-Kaap, or Cape Malay Quarter (so named for those peoples exiled to the Cape from Dutch colonies in the East).

Leave the vehicles for a historic walk through the Company Gardens, a fresh produce garden for ships and locals from the mid-17th century, and now home to the SA Museum, Houses of Parliament, National Gallery and St. George's Cathedral.

Stroll through the city to Greenmarket Square, where you can browse the bustling market stalls for beautiful and unique African mementos. From there drive to the Castle, South Africa's oldest building, with its formidable collection of Old Cape paintings. Take in the nearby Grand Parade, where Nelson Mandela addressed the nation on his release in 1990, and then move on to the District Six Museum, which showcases the colorful life of this legendary area and the forced relocation of its residents during the Apartheid era.

Entrance fees to the SA Museum, Castle of Good Hope and District Six Museum are included – other points of interest are optional.

Day 03



You will be collected from Cape Grace and taken on a Private Full Day Peninsula Tour inclusive of entrance fees to Seal cruise, Cape Point, Funicular, Penguins, Kirstenbosch and Chapman's Peak Drive and lunch.

Private Full Day Peninsula Tour

Highlights

- Travel through many famous coastal suburbs of the Cape and traverse one of the world's most spectacular passes – Chapman's Peak.
- Visit the African penguin colony at Boulders Beach as well as the Cape fur seal colony on Duiker Island (weather dependent).
- Catch a glimpse of Southern right whales (seasonal) off the Cape's longest beach.
- Spot wildlife in the Table Mountain National Park, and explore the rocky coastline, the Cape fynbos vegetation and the south-westernmost point of Africa – Cape Point – and its lighthouse.
- Stroll through world-famous Kirstenbosch Botanical Gardens at the foot of Table Mountain.
- Lunch at an a la carte coastal restaurant.

We make our way along the Atlantic seaboard passing Sea Point, Bantry Bay and Clifton. Bakoven and Llandudno, with their ghostly shipwrecks, are also fantastic sights on the way to the fishing village of Hout Bay, where we board a boat to view the Cape fur seal colony on Duiker Island (weather dependent).

From here we navigate the 114 curves of 600m high Chapman's Peak Drive. We enter the Cape of Good Hope section of the Table Mountain National Park with its unique Cape fynbos vegetation and home to birds like African black oystercatchers and Cape sugarbirds as well as to very special fauna including Cape mountain zebra, bontebok (both endemic) and the charismatic Cape baboon.

Climb (or ride the world's first environmentally friendly funicular) to the famous Cape Point Lighthouse to capture the magical vistas of False Bay.

After lunch, we visit Boulders Beach to see the penguins, and then head home through the naval village of Simonstown and over scenic Boyes Drive, taking in the views of the fishing harbour at Kalk Bay and the seaside havens of St. James and Muizenberg.

To round off your day you can take a stroll through Kirstenbosch Botanical Gardens on the slopes of Table Mountain.

Day 04

You will be collected from the Cape Grace Hotel and taken on a Private Full Day Winelands Tour inclusive of entrance fees to Wine Tasting, Cellar Tour, Museums and lunch.



Private Full Day Winelands Tour

Highlights

- Taste some of South Africa's finest wines in the beautiful Boland region.
- Visit wine estates according to your preferences.
- Lunch at one of the many classic, award-winning restaurants.
- Explore the rich history and culture of towns such as Stellenbosch and gastronomic Franschhoek.

Depart the city for the Winelands in the nearby Boland Mountains for a leisurely exploration of historic towns, liquid delights, gastronomic wonders and home-grown hospitality.

Wine estates visited will vary according to client preferences, but the tour generally includes the region's major wine producing areas of Stellenbosch, Paarl and Franschhoek, and there are chances aplenty en route for tastings of world-renowned reds and whites, as well as Cap Classiques – South Africa's answer to "Champagne".

Lunch at one of the many classic, award-winning restaurants in the area.

Natural and historic heritage abounds in this area and your tour may take in sights like the Afrikaans Language Monument with its panoramic Boland views. Idyllic Franschhoek, nestled in a valley settled by French Huguenots in 1688, is a delight for both antique lovers and gastronomes alike.

Stellenbosch, South Africa's second-oldest town, provides another glimpse of classic 17th century Cape style, with a chance to browse quaint Dorp Street and the many museums, galleries and shops of this lovely university town.

Day 05

Private road transfer from Cape Grace Hotel to Cape Town International Airport.

Scheduled commercial flight from Cape Town International Airport to Skukuza Airport (flight cost is additional and not included in cost of safari).
