## Zimbabwe Wildlife Highlights

7 Nights/8 Days



Experience three diverse areas of Zimbabwe from the wilderness of granite in the Matopos Region to Zimbabwe's premier wildlife destination of Hwange National Park to a stunning camp set on the banks of the mighty Zambezi River.

### Itinerary:

#### Day 1:

Arrive at Bulawayo Airport where you will be transferred by road transfer to Camp Amalinda (Matobo Hills)

#### Camp Amalinda



**Room:** Standard Suite

**Arrival:** Day 01

**Departure:** Day 03

**Included:** All meals, all local beverages, 2 activities, laundry and free airport transfer to / from Bulawayo Airport/Town.

Camp Amalinda, A Wilderness of Granite, is situated just outside the Matopos National Park, 45 km outside of Bulawayo. Camp Amalinda has nine exquisite luxury rooms set within the granite boulders. Each of these rooms has a distinctive look and feel, giving Amalinda's guests a unique accommodation experience.

The lodges all have electric blankets for the winter season, showers and toilets (built into the granite) and the camp is open to children of all ages.

**Did you know?**

- Activities include hikes to the tops of giant granite *dwalas* (rocks), walks to the world-renowned caves and viewing of bushman paintings, game drives, abseiling, rhino walks and access to the spa and salon.
- The Matopos Region has been classified as a world heritage site and is home to a profusion of wildlife.
- Some of the prolific species found here are the black eagle, a high population of leopard and black and white rhino.

**Day 3:**

Scheduled road transfer from Camp Amalinda to Hwange Main Camp. On arrival at Hwange Main Camp, you will be transferred by road to Davison's Camp.

**Davison's Camp**

**Arrival:** Day 03

**Departure:** Day 06

**Included:** FI rate includes accommodation, all meals, twice daily scheduled camp activities, park fees, laundry and all local drinks – excludes premium imported brands and champagne.

Within Zimbabwe's premier wildlife destination and conservation area lies the beautifully positioned **Davison's Camp**. As one of the few camps located within the Park boundaries, Davison's will offer you complete privacy, as well as a compelling mix of diverse wildlife. The camp's nine en-suite tents are hidden in the shade of false mopane trees and from the comfort of your veranda you will be able to watch the continuous procession of game at the waterhole. In between activities, while the hours away in our main area as you observe the thriving life around camp and contemplate the splendour of Hwange.

**Did you know?**

- We have partnered with the National Park in jointly combating the effects of poaching along Hwange's southern boundary, an area beyond our concession.
- The park is predominately Kalahari sandveld supporting teak and mopane woodlands, dry acacia scrub and is interspersed with salt pans and grasslands.
- Guided walks may also be arranged on request.
- You will typically see elephant, buffalo, sable, roan, southern giraffe, blue wildebeest, impala and sometimes even gemsbok. Lion, leopard, wild dog and cheetah are regularly sighted.
- Birdlife is prolific with more than 400 species found here.

## Ruckomechi Camp



**Room:** Tented Room

**Arrival:** Day 06

**Departure:** Day 08

**Included:** All meals, daily activities, laundry and drinks (excluding premium import brands)

Set on the banks of the dominating Zambezi River brimming with hippo, the biodiversity surrounding **Ruckomechi Camp** is a naturalist's paradise. A large grove of acacia and mahogany trees with a fabulous mountainous backdrop across in Zambia sets the scene, while large numbers of elephant, buffalo and eland create the excitement. With these stunning views also evident from your spacious en-suite tent, you will be smitten with the secluded outdoor 'bath-with-a-view'. Low-level walkways connect the 10 guest tents to the beautifully designed central dining, bar, library and lounge areas. For your comfort we also have a separate deck with an infinity pool for swimming and sunbathing, and an inviting, cushion-strewn star-gazing deck.

### Did you know?

- We aim to be as environmentally friendly as possible – hot water and lighting for each unit is provided by solar power.
- The area is famous for its four main pools which hold water all year round drawing all manner of wildlife during the dry season. Also enjoyed at this time of year are the protein-rich pods produced by the plentiful ana trees that characterise the floodplain.
- Your activities include game drives (day and night), guided walks (on request), boating, canoeing and fishing.
- Predators such as lions, leopard, wild dog and cheetah are often seen.
- Over 350 birds have been recorded including Collared Palm-Thrush, Purple-banded Sunbird and Black-throated Wattle-Eye
