Kenya Migration Safari
Options 1 and 2

10 nights/11days

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ITINERARY

Day 1: Arrive Nairobi, Fairmont Norfolk Hotel

Arrive in Nairobi, where you are met by a safari guide and transferred to the historic Fairmont Norfolk Hotel for one night.

Days 2 & 3: Amboseli National Park

This morning we travel to Amboseli National Park (approximately a 2 ½ hour drive), arriving at our camp for lunch. With snowcapped Kilimanjaro rising in the distance, Amboseli is considered one of the most photogenic of Kenya's parks and reserves. Amboseli is one of East Africa's best locations for observing elephant and birdlife, with more than 450 species recorded. Greater and Lesser Flamingos frequent the shallow margins of Amboseli's lakes. Following wildlife viewing each day, we return to the isolated comfort of our camp for the night. Breakfast, lunch and dinner are included.

Day 4: Mount Kenya Safari Club

Our journey continues as we wind our way through the picturesque rolling hills of Mount Kenya (approximately 5-6 hour drive with lunch in Nairobi), which is over 7,000 feet above sea level, to arrive at the Mount Kenya Safari Club. Built at the base of Mount Kenya, this luxurious country home has become a Kenyan tradition. The original house, with its many guest rooms, was converted into an inn in 1948 and later purchased by the late actor William Holden, who established it as one of the most exclusive clubs in the world. The late afternoon is free to swim or visit the wildlife nursery located on the ground. You will overnight at the Fairmount Mount Kenya Safari Club with breakfast, lunch and dinner included.

Options 1 and 2: Mount Kenya Safari Club

Days 5 & 6: Samburu Game Reserve

Today we travel to Samburu, located in Kenya's Northern Frontier District to Samburu (approximately a 2 ½ hour drive). Unique to this harsh region are Grevy's Zebra, Somali Ostrich, Beisa Oryx, Gerenuk, Yellow Baboon, Guenther's Dik-dik and Reticulated Giraffe. This is the land of the Samburu (related to the Masai). Morning and afternoon game drives will give us opportunities to explore and search for abundant wildlife. We spend the next two nights at our camp with breakfast, lunch and dinner included.
