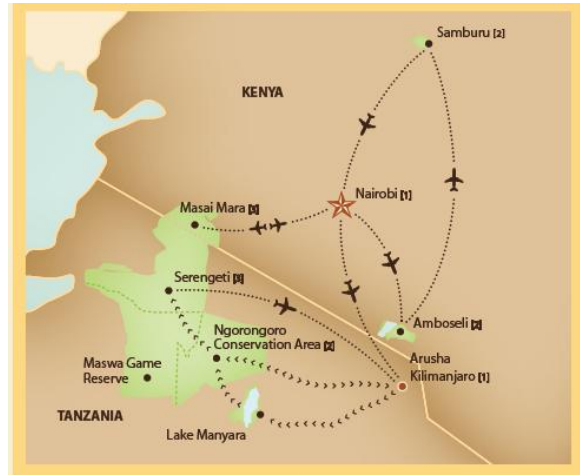
Serengeti Option - 12 Days

(Best time to travel: December – June)

This very special safari has something to offer the first time traveler to Africa or the safari enthusiast planning a tenth wildlife pilgrimage!

Highlights:

- Explore from above with aerial gameviewing as you fly between locations maximizing your safari time each step of the way
- Discover the beauty of Amboseli with its famous large tusked elephants and the peaks of Mount Kilimanjaro visible in the background on a clear day
- Experience the thrill of tracking Africa's prey and predators on daily game drives in search of a dazzle of zebra, pods of hippo or a cackle of hyena
- Enjoy the palette of an East African sunset with a quintessential African tradition – the "sundowner drink"



Day 1 Nairobi, Kenya

You will join the spirits of Teddy Roosevelt and Winston Churchill on your first night in Nairobi.

Accommodation: House of Waine in Nairobi.

Days 2-3 Amboseli

Wing South to Amboseli, where you will discover local wildlife against the stunning backdrop of Mt. Kilimanjaro.



Accommodation: Satao Elerai Camp, Amboseli

Days 4-5 Samburu

From South to North, fly to the semi-arid Samburu region. During your two-night stay, you're bound to see many herds of elephant as well as other species which are unique to the region: reticulated giraffe and the long necked gerenuk.

Accommodation: Ashnil Camp, Samburu

Day 6 Arusha, Tanzania

Today's flight takes you across the border to Arusha. Visit the Shanga Workshop, which employs disabled, deaf and mute workers to make their crafts.

Accommodation: Arusha Coffee Lodge, Arusha

Days 7-8 Ngorongoro Crater

Spend the morning exploring Manyara National Park, in the Great Rift Valley on the way to your two nights lodging near Ngorongoro. Enjoy an excursion to the crater floor to view lion, hyena and black rhino to name a few, walk among the adjacent foothills and visit a local Masai manyatta.



Accommodation: Plantation Lodge, Ngorongoro

Days 9-11 Serengeti

The legendary Serengeti is your home for the next three nights. Enjoy numerous opportunities to photographically capture your own Big Five as well as other bountiful wildlife species.

Accommodation: Olakira Camp, Serengeti

Day 12 Depart

A late morning drive brings you back to Arusha where you relax until the evening departure of your international flight home.

Accommodations: As specified in the itinerary, or similar, will be provided in hotels, lodges camps based on two persons sharing a room with private bath or shower. The right is reserved to substitute hotels, camps, and lodges when necessary. Service charges and taxes are included for all accommodations.

Internal flights are included in the land arrangements as noted.

Single Accommodations: are at an additional cost as indicated in the programs.

Meals: Breakfasts: 11, Lunches: 11, Dinners: 9

Transfers: between airports, rail stations, motor coach terminals and hotels are provided, when specified, throughout with two pieces of luggage per person.

Revisions to Itinerary: A fee of \$100 will be charged for a revision to a confirmed itinerary.

Late Booking Fee: A fee for additional communications and expedited mail costs will be charged when applicable.

NOT INCLUDED

LAND prices do not include international airfares, costs of obtaining passports, visas, inoculations, excess baggage charges, all items of a personal nature such as drinks, laundry, telephone calls and cables, meals not specified in the itinerary, personal and baggage insurance, local airport taxes and tips to waiters, hotel staff, game rangers and sightseeing drivers and guides.

Tips to tour guides, waiters, hotel staff, baggage handling and game rangers are not included and are at the tour participant's discretion.

Taxes and fees imposed by governments and other authorities are not included in the air fares quoted.

Refunds will not be made for occasional missed meals or services, or for any absence from the tour of less than 4 consecutive days, or for hotel accommodations not utilized.

The costs of any visas required are not included in the quoted cost.
