### **Day 1: Dar es Salaam**

Upon your arrival at Dar es Salaam International Airport you will be met and transferred to The Oyster Bay Hotel.

Despite its name, which means “abode of peace” in Arabic, Dar es Salaam is Tanzania's largest and busiest city. It is the country's most important business and commercial hub and is situated right on the Indian Ocean. It is the main port of call for most visitors as it is an ideal place from which to access both the wilderness areas and the beaches of Tanzania and Zanzibar. Most visitors en route to the better-known Tanzanian attractions are surprised by the charm of this unassuming city and find themselves yearning for more days to explore its hidden secrets. Must-see attractions include the beautiful beaches of Kunduchi, Mjimwena and Mbwa Maji, Dar es Salaam’s spectacular harbour and shopping at the local markets.

Spend one night at The Oyster Bay. Accommodation is in a luxury suite. Your stay includes all meals, teas and coffees, soft drinks, local beers, wines and laundry.

### **Days 2 - 4: Selous Game Reserve**

After a wholesome breakfast you will be driven back to Dar es Salaam International Airport where you will board your scheduled flight to Selous Game Reserve. Upon arrival you be driven to Beho Beho.



Secluded and off-the-beaten track, **Selous Game Reserve** offers visitors a slice of undisturbed wilderness, teeming with a spectacular array of fauna and flora. It was declared a World Heritage Site due to its dramatic landscapes and great diversity of wildlife. The Selous Game Reserve is one of the only big game reserves to allow hiking, offering wildlife enthusiasts the chance to explore Tanzania’s pristine landscapes on foot. This is a superb and extremely exciting safari experience, in Tanzania's largest conservation area, and should not be missed.

Spend three nights at **Beho Beho**. Accommodation is in a stone and palm thatched banda. Your stay includes three meals daily, soft drinks, house wines, local brand spirits and beers, teas and coffees, scheduled safari activities and laundry.

Adventures include walking safaris in the Selous, boat cruises and game drives in open 4x4 safari vehicles.

#### **Insider's tips**

- Beho Beho's experienced guides will plan your safari programme, whether you need time to relax and be pampered or release some energy on a game walk before breakfast in the bush.
- Spend a day exploring the beautiful Tagalala Lake on the lodge's boat and get up close with large huddles of hippo and rafts of crocodiles.
- Ask your hosts to take you to the natural hot springs for a therapeutic dip.

#### **Day 5: Dar es Salaam**

After breakfast you will be transferred to the airstrip where you board your scheduled flight to Dar es Salaam Domestic Airport. On arrival you will be transferred to Dares Salaam International Airport where our services end.
