Family Safari 10 Day Flying Safari

Enjoy an exhilarating family adventure packed with bonding moments and precious memories. Tour the wild and indulge in new explorations together as a team and leave with lasting family experiences.

DAYS 1 - 3: AMBOSELI NATIONAL PARK, Tortilis Camp

On arrival at Jomo Kenyatta International Airport you will be met and transferred to Wilson Airport for the scheduled Safarilink flight to Amboseli. You will be collected from the airstrip and taken to Tortilis Camp, where you will be greeted by the beauty of Africa's largest mountain, Mt. Kilimanjaro. You will spend three nights at Tortilis Camp.



Tortilis Camp consists of 17 traditional en-suite tents built raised above the ground, with spacious verandahs. There is also a family suite made up of one double and one twin room and a shared sitting and dining area. Activities include game drives, bush walks, sundowners, cultural visits to the nearby Manyatta (Maasai Hut), massage and a swimming pool to play in when the animals are sleeping in the heat of the day. There are over 1,000 elephants in the park's eco-system, featuring some of the largest elephants in Africa.

DAYS 4 - 6: LEWA DOWNS CONSERVANCY, Lewa Wilderness

You will take the Safari link scheduled flight from Amboseli to Wilson where you will connect with the flight to Lewa. On arrival you will be met by your driver guide who will transfer you to Lewa Safari Camp for your three night stay.

Lewa Wilderness is situated within one of Kenya's major private conservation successes. It is set



within beautiful countryside at the foot of Mount Kenya and can offer some great game viewing opportunities. Some of the species that are found on Lewa are the endangered Rhino, both black and white, grevy's Zebra and Sitatunga. Situated in the Northwest of the Conservancy, this luxury tented safari camp offers all the comforts of home: steamy hot showers, flush toilets, warm comfy beds at the end of a long day's game viewing.

DAYS 7 - 9: MASAI MARA, Elephant Pepper Camp

After breakfast you will be transferred to the airstrip for the Safari Link scheduled flight to the Masai Mara. On arrival you will be met by your driver guide who will transfer you to Elephant Pepper Camp where you will spend the next three nights.



Elephant Pepper Camp is in Koiyaki Community Ranch on the border of the Masai Mara. At camp we bring you back to nature; no generator, no traffic, no permanent structures, just the sights and sounds of the bush with all the luxuries you need. Each of the eight tents are ensuite. Sitting around a campfire discussing your unforgettable 'finds' of the day is an experience all want to repeat. Activities include day & night game drives, bush walks, bush meals, sundowners and cultural visits. For children Elephant Pepper is great - the Masai camp staff will spend hours teaching them about identifying tracks, dung and insects, making bows and arrows and learning how to bake bread, bush pasta and many other delights in a camp kitchen.

DAY 10: DEPARTURE

After a last game drive in the Masai Mara, catch the Safarilink flight back to Nairobi. A driver will meet and transfer you to your Nairobi hotel or to the international airport for your journey home.
