Day 2

You will be collected from Cape Grace Hotel and taken on a scheduled half day City Tour.

Experience Cape Town in a Microbus taking a maximum of 12 passengers.

Depart city for Tafelberg Road and the Lower Cable Station. For those wishing to summit Table Mountain (optional extra), board the revolving cable car for a 5-minute ride to the top of this legendary promontory. 1036 meters above sea level, it affords bird's-eye views of the city, Table Bay and the Peninsula, as you explore its summit. (If Cableway is closed due to inclement weather, the tour will drive up nearby Signal Hill). Continue your orientation of the city; drive through the streets of Cape Town, with your guide explaining the history and significance of some of its most important landmarks. There are stops en route, which include the restored 17/18th Century Castle of Good Hope and the fascinating treasures of the SA Museum.

The tour terminates at the Victoria & Alfred Waterfront.

Day 3

You will be collected from Cape Grace Hotel and taken on a scheduled full day Peninsula tour excluding lunch.

Depart the city along the spectacular Atlantic Seaboard, en route to the fishing village of Hout Bay where (as an optional extra) take a half-hour cruise to see Cape Fur Seals, or explore the harbor, visiting its fish markets and shops.

Continue over the 600m heights of Chapman's Peak Drive, one of the world's most breath-taking passes and past the Cape's longest beach, with a chance to spot Southern Right Whales just offshore from June and November.



Enter the Cape of Good Hope National Park for a walk (or optional funicular ride) up to the Cape Point Lighthouse, to take in magical ocean vistas at this, the south westernmost point in Africa.

Head along the False Bay coast to Boulders Beach near Simonstown to see a colony of African penguins and then continue past the seaside resorts of False Bay, towards the city.

The last stop of the day is Kirstenbosch Botanical Gardens, for a walk through one of the largest collections of indigenous plants in the world.

PLEASE NOTE:

Transport is by Microbus, seating a maximum of 12 passengers.

A lunch stop will be made en route and is not included in the cost.

The cruise to Seal Island and funicular ride at Cape Point are optional extras.

Day 4

You will be collected from Cape Grace Hotel and taken on a scheduled full day Winelands tour excluding lunch.

Experience the Cape Winelands in a Microbus taking a maximum of 12 passengers.

Leave the city and travel some 50 minutes toward the Boland Mountains and the wine country to explore the famous vineyards of the Cape. Visit one of the wineries for a cellar tour and learn about the winemaking methods practiced here with an opportunity to taste some of the wines these areas have to offer.

Visit Stellenbosch, the second oldest town in the country, with its tree lined streets and classic Cape Dutch architecture for which it is famous. A short stop will be made in this university town.



Stop at the Boschendal wine estate and visit the beautifully restored manor house en route to Franschhoek, where the Huguenots first settled in 1688. The Franschhoek area still retains some of its French Heritage. Explore this quaint town with its many shops and galleries.

Thereafter visit Paarl, home of the Afrikaans Language Monument, before returning to Cape Town.

A lunch stop will be made en route and is not included in the cost.

Savanna Lodge is situated in the western sector of the game-rich Sabi Sand Reserve, bordering the Kruger National Park. There are 3 executive suites, 4 luxury suites and the Savanna Suites.



Each suite has their own indigenous garden area, and air-conditioning, plus en suite bathrooms. The executive suites have a lounge area, bath and double shower, private outside shower, wooden deck and plunge pool while the luxury suites offer a private verandah and bath and single shower. The Savanna Suites comprises two separate, en suite bedrooms, separated by a large lounge and dining room - all under thatch and offers all the creature comforts including air conditioning, bathroom with a large bath, double shower and an outside shower. Each bedroom has a wooden

deck and private plunge pool. There is a fully equipped kitchen, fireplace and TV with multi channel access and DVD player. The central facilities include a lounge and dining room built under thatch with views of the beautiful and a few metres further, the waterhole. Guests enjoy a traditional meal in the open air “boma” which overlooks a floodlit waterhole. There is an upstairs Library with Wireless broadband internet access as well as a Curio shop. Savanna Tented Camp has traversing rights to over 10.000 hectares of bushveld. Early morning, late afternoon and evening game drives are led by professional game rangers. Daily trips to a Shangaan Village are also offered for an additional cost.

Londolozi Private Game Reserve is set in 14 000 hectares of the Sabi Sand Game Reserve and is famous for its leopard sightings. Londolozi Tree Camp boasts 6 luxurious suites surrounded by large shady trees with views of the Sand River. Each air-conditioned suite offers an en suite bathroom, private deck with plunge pool, outdoor shower and sala. The central living area has a lounge area, library and a game viewing dining deck. Candlelit dinners are enjoyed in

the boma, while the camp also organises moonlit bush dinners and private bush breakfasts. During the day guests can relax by the lodge pool in the camp's garden. Dynamic presentations are offered in the interpretive centre. A fully equipped gym is available at Varty Camp, and daily sunrise and sunset yoga classes are offered. Activities centre around twice daily game drives in open vehicles under the guidance of skilled rangers and trackers. Bird watching and guided bush walks are also offered and there are excellent photographic opportunities.
